



## **GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTICE**

Postgraduate training in the general medical practice (family medicine) implemented in educational institutions of higher professional education is a set of documents developed and approved by the university, taking into account the needs of the labor market, the requirements of state executive bodies in accordance with government requirements to postgraduate medical education programs in clinical residency. A general practitioner is a doctor who has been trained in accordance with the qualification required for a general practitioner. The general practitioner works in the primary care system and is responsible for providing continuous medical care to each patient who applied for it, regardless of his age and gender, and the nature of his illness. The general practitioner provides medical care to the patient, taking into account the peculiarities of his family, society, his culture, ensuring compliance with the principle of patient's individuality.

### **The tasks of clinical residency in the «general practitioner» specialty include:**

- enhancement of professional knowledge and skills in mastering the basics of early diagnosis, differential diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation and emergency care for the most common diseases;
- professional development, the formation of integrated thinking to provide comprehensive primary care at all stages of medical care and preventive work and to protect the health of a patient of any age and gender;
- mastering advanced medical technologies and introducing them into practical healthcare;
- mastering the knowledge of the legal base of the profession of general practitioner and knowledge of the norms of medical ethics and deontology.
