Postgraduate education in “Obstetrics and Gynecology” provides professional training for an obstetrician-gynecologist with deep theoretical and practical knowledge of diagnostics, prevention and treatment of a wide range of physiology and pathology of obstetrics, and gynecology and having the legal right to provide medical assistance in an amount appropriate qualification characteristics of the doctor of this specialty.

The tasks of clinical internship in the specialty "obstetrics-gynecology" include:

- enhancement of professional knowledge and skills in mastering of socio-economic and biomedical basics of family medicine, to give in-depth theoretical knowledge on practical healthcare, on the medical-biological and social aspects of medical practice, on the epidemiology of common human diseases, on topical issues of clinical medicine;
- develop independent clinical thinking aimed at the effective use of acquired knowledge in the provision of timely, qualified medical and medico-social assistance to all groups of the population;
- develop the student's practical skills of community-acquired diagnosis of common diseases and provision of qualified primary medical care to adults, including medical manipulations on pre-hospital obstetric and gynecological, surgical medical care, as well as training in primary resuscitation and intensive care;
- provide a basic level of humanities knowledge and teach the basics of the practical application of medical informatics, medical psychology and psychotherapy, provide an opportunity to master a foreign language.
